## Praised be Jesus Christ!

The day of priestly ordination always remains in the memory of presbyters. At the end of April 2018, we commemorated **the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the ordination of St. Maximilian Maria Kolbe**, who was received in Rome on April 28, 1918 in the Basilica of St. Andrew of the Valley.

St. Maximillian always wanted to save the world through the Immaculate Mary and therefore he completely entrusted himself to Her.

He even often said that if She wanted, She could let him die. St. Kolbe wanted to gain the world for Immaculate Mary, so his life and death were providential in the perspective of what happened later. One can say that St. Maximillian was a kind of an igniter and the great flame spread just after his death.

A new movie titled **Two Crowns** released last October - on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the apparitions in Fatima and on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of establishing the Knight of the Immaculate



Mary you have the opportunity please watch this movie. The film shows that Fr Maximillian was a volcano of positive energy and fully enjoyed life.

He was a man who went far beyond his time and schemes. Watching "Two crowns", you will wipe your eyes by surprise to see what Fr. Maximillian was interested in, what ideas he had and what he was trying to implement in life. For example this movie shows how Fr. Maximillian goes to Japan, without knowing this exotic language at all and financial security, and after a month of his arrival there, he published the 'Knight of Immaculate Mary' in Japanese, which has been published till today.

St. Maximillian is our master and guide in the recognition and worship of the Immaculate.

Soon we are approaching August 14<sup>th</sup>, the feast of St. Maximilian - a man beloved especially by every Pole and Polish American. <u>A</u> <u>Novena of prayers through his intercession will precede it.</u> Franciscan like St. Maximilian wish to serve mankind, the Mother of God, and the Most High God through evangelization and catechizations of succeeding generations of Polonia, spread beyond the boundaries of the USA and Canada, encompassing the whole world.
